

### Going to - functions


#### "Be going to "

- We use "be going to"
- For plans, intentions or ambitions for the future

She is going to become a doctor when she grows up.

Actions we have already decided to do in the near future


Paul is going to visit his aunt this weekend.





Use "Be going to" to make a prediction based on some evidence (something that you see or know):




"Fernando Alonso is going to win the race!"




"This boy is going to fall down the tree!"
