

### Use 1

### REASONS TO USE THE PRESENT PERFECT

1. AN ACTION STARTED IN THE PAST AND CONTINUES
TO THE PRESENT (THE PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS
CAN ALSO BE USED FOR THIS REASON)

THEY HAVE KNOWN EACH OTHER SINCE THEY WERE CHILDREN.

THIS STARTED IN THE PAST AND IS STILL TRUE NOW.

2. AN ACTION HAPPENED DURING A TIME PERIOD THAT HAS NOT YET FINISHED (THIS MONTH/YEAR)

THE PRESENT PERFECT CAN BE USED FOR AN ACTION THAT WAS RECENTLY FINISHED.



## Revision – other examples



• We use the present perfect tense to talk about actions that started in the past and continue to the present.

e.g. I've grown flowers for two years.

### Present perfect tense


- We use the present perfect tense to talk about completed actions.
  - e.g. (a) Charlie is eating the sandwich.



(b) Charlie has eaten the sandwich.

## How long Since-for

### Present perfect tense

- We use How long ... with the present perfect tense to ask the length of a period of time.
  - e.g. How long have you stayed here?
- We use either since or for to answer How long questions.
  - e.g. I have stayed here since 1992.

OR

I have stayed here for ten years.

# Yet-already

YET IS USED WITH THE PRESENT PERFECT TENSE IN NEGATIVE STATEMENTS AND QUESTIONS.

EX. THE MAIL HASN'T ARRIVED YET.

NOT IN THE TIME BETWEEN A PAST TIME AND NOW.

ALREADY IS USED IN POSITIVE STATEMENTS WHEN AN ACTION IS COMPLETED BEFORE WE EXPECTED.



# Other examples Ever-never



## Present perfect vs past simple

### Present perfect tense

- We use the present perfect tense when we do not know the time of an action.
- We do not usually use these phrases with the present perfect tense (e.g. yesterday, last week, in 1999, on Monday).
  - ★ I have washed the dishes yesterday.

    OR
  - I washed the dishes yesterday.

# Present perfect vs past simple 1

### EXTRA INFORMATION ABOUT THE PRESENT PERFECT

THE PRESENT PERFECT IS NOT USED WITH A SPECIFIC TIME IN THE PAST UNLESS THE WORD SINCE IS USED.

EX. I HAVE VISITED PARIS. VI HAVE VISITED PARIS LAST MONTH.

### EXTRA INFORMATION ABOUT THE PRESENT PERFECT

THE PRESENT PERFECT IS NOT USED WITH A SPECIFIC TIME IN THE PAST UNLESS THE WORD SINCE IS USED.

EX. I HAVE VISITED PARIS. V

# Present perfect vs past simple 2

### EXTRA INFORMATION ABOUT THE PRESENT PERFECT

THE PRESENT PERFECT IS NOT USED WITH A SPECIFIC TIME IN THE PAST UNLESS THE WORD SINCE IS USED.

```
I HAVE VISITED PARIS LAST MONTH. X

I HAVE PLAYED TENNIS. V

I HAVE PLAYED TENNIS. WHEN I WAS A CHILD. X
```

### EXTRA INFORMATION ABOUT THE PRESENT PERFECT

THE PRESENT PERFECT IS NOT USED WITH A SPECIFIC TIME IN THE PAST UNLESS THE WORD SINCE IS USED.

EX. I HAVE VISITED PARIS. VI I HAVE VISITED PARIS LAST MONTH.

I HAVE PLAYED TENNIS. VI HAVE PLAYED TENNIS WHEN I WAS A CHILD.




