EXAMPLES IN SONGS

- I was going over the Cork and Kerry Mountains
I saw Captain Farrell and his money he was countin' (Metallica)
- Saw cinderella in a party dress but she was looking for her nightgown
(the Killers)

OTHER EXAMPLES

- I heard the mission bell and I was thinking to myself "this could be Heaven or this could be Hell" (Eagle)
- I was cryin' when I met you
Now I'm tryn' to forget you
Love is sweet misery (Aerosmith)
- I was hoping that I could leave this star crossed world behind (the Killers)

AFFIRMATIVE

NEGATIVE

INTERROGATIVE

Esempio:

I was working (IO STAVO LAVORANDO)

They were playing (LORO STAVANO GIOCANDO)

Esempio:

I wasn't reading (IO NON STAVO LEGGENDO)

They weren't playing (LORO NON STAVANO GIOCANDO)

Esempio:

were you working ?(STAVI LAVORANDO?)

was Bob playing ? (BOB STAVA GIOCANDO?)

RULES

<p>SOGGETTO + WERE/WAS + VERBO IN FORMA -ING</p>	<p>SOGGETTO + WERE/WAS + NOT + VERBO IN FORMA -ING</p>	<p>WERE/WAS + SOGGETTO + VERBO IN FORMA -ING</p>
<p>N.B.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• La forma -ing si ottiene aggiungendo questo suffisso alla forma presente WORK > WORKING• Se il verbo finisce con -l essa raddoppia TRAVEL > TRAVELLING	<p>N.B.</p> <p>Il verbo essere seguito dal NOT da esito alla forma contratta:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Wasn't- Weren't

WHILE



Use **past progressive** with **while** to describe two actions in progress at the same time in the past.



past

The man **was reading** the newspaper **while** the woman **was eating** her ice cream.



future

was reading
was eating

now

WHEN



Use past progressive with simple past to describe an action that was interrupted by another action.



past

They **were enjoying** the morning when the thief **stole** the briefcase.



future

were enjoying

stole

now
