## **The indefinite article** = L'articolo indeterminativo

L'articolo indeterminativo **A** (= un, uno, una) si usa quando la parola immediatamente successiva inizia con un suono consonantico o con H aspirata (l' "acca che si pronuncia"):

E.g. <u>a</u> cat, <u>a</u> ruler, <u>a</u> week, <u>a</u> pencil, <u>a</u> book...

<u>a</u> hamster, <u>a</u> heart, <u>a</u> hospital, <u>a</u> horse, <u>a</u> hundred, <u>a</u> hat, <u>a</u> hair, <u>a</u> helicopter, <u>a</u> hotel, <u>a</u> hamburger...

L'articolo indeterminativo *AN* si usa quando la parola immediatamente successiva inizia con un suono vocalico o con H muta:

E.g. <u>an</u> eye, <u>an</u> arm, <u>an</u> ear, <u>an</u> orange, <u>an</u> umbrella, <u>an</u> exercise...

an hour, an honor, an harbor...

NOTA BENE: quando la parola inizia con un DITTONGO, si usa A:

= unione di due vocali

/ju/

E.g. a university

In questo caso, /ju/ di "university" non è un suono vocalico unico, ma sono due vocali; quindi, conta come un dittongo e si usa *A*.
